



Leisure Rink Public Skating Fall 2020 Sessions

General Guidelines

- Skaters under the age of 7 must be accompanied on ice by an adult
- Helmets are mandatory for all skaters under 18 years of age
- No chairs, shoes, sticks or pucks allowed on the ice

Max Capacity

- **Maximum 10** participants on the ice Public Skating session.
- **Admission: \$5.00** per participant
- No spectators. Unfortunately we do not have space in the Leisure Rink for spectators.

Booking

- Online booking for sessions is available **9:00am** the day of the session at:

- All skaters must pre-book & pre-pay for the session

Entry to Facility

- Participants can arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the start of session
- Participants must exit within 10 minutes of the end of the session
- Participants must check-in with the host/admin staff upon entry
- Participants must complete health questionnaire prior to stepping on the ice:

Dressing Areas

- Participants are to use the benches and chairs in the Leisure Rink.
- Participants are asked to stay physically distant from other skaters outside their bubble

Equipment

- Participants must bring their own equipment with them. Skate Rentals and skating aids are not available at this time
- Water fountains and water bottle fill stations are not available for use.

On-ice Guidelines

- Participants are asked to maintain 2m distance from other skaters on and off the ice at all times unless they are in the same household or cohort.
